It is my pleasure to present the 2011 JewishCare Annual Report that reflects the healthy financial status of the organisation. Although I have been on the Board since 2006, becoming President has given me further insight into the people who make JewishCare such a unique and important organisation which this year celebrates 75 years of helping people in need in our community.

The JewishCare team lead by CEO Claire Vernon and the senior management team continue to impress me with their efficient and caring approach. This capable leadership, together with our dedicated Board are well placed to serve the needs of the community and achieve our vision.

SOME HIGHLIGHTS OF THE PAST YEAR...

We have signed an agreement with the Chai Foundation to continue the vital funding assistance the Foundation provides to those in need.

Two initiatives that play an increasingly important role to increase awareness of and reduce the incidence of domestic violence in our community are The White Ribbon Day and 16 Days 16 Rabbis 16 Synagogues. I am pleased that the NSW government is supporting our work in this area with a \$100,000 grant over the next 2 years.

JewishCare's Mental Health program has gone from strength to strength, continuing to help families and individuals with mental health issues. The Seder that was held in April was a moving and powerful occasion where clients and others with special needs came together to celebrate Pesach.

JewishCare continues to be a primary provider of care for older people in our community. We assist people to remain at home and support families who are caring for loved ones. We are proud to acknowledge the very positive findings of the Commonwealth Department of Health's quality survey on our Aged Home Support program. The survey highlighted achievement of best practice in a number of areas.

During the Appeal, nobody in Sydney could have failed to notice the orange hands stuck on thousands of cars. Not only did the Appeal bring together over 1000 donors who pledged close to \$5million, it also provided a unique opportunity to engage with our community. I have no doubt that as a result of the media campaign, the positive word of mouth, the 14 functions, Professor Alan Dershowitz's unsolicited public support of JewishCare at the NSW Jewish Board of Deputies function held

at the Central Synagogue, the message regarding JewishCare's important role was strongly reinforced.

With the financial goals of the Appeal having been achieved we have commenced building the new headquarters for JewishCare at the Saber Street site in Bondi Junction. The development is proceeding on schedule and we look forward to serving the community from our new home mid 2012.

The success of the Capital Appeal was a result of the commitment and inspiration of the Capital Appeal Committee led by Alex Abulafia as Chairman, together with Allen and Ali Linz, Michelle Katz, Philip Carr and the entire Care Aware group who were inspired all along the way by then President, Eva Fischl OAM.

The conclusion of the Appeal marked the end of an era with Eva's retirement after fourteen years as President of JewishCare. Much of the organisation's standing in the community has been a result of Eva's involvement, leadership and unwavering commitment over a 14 year period which saw the organisation go from strength to strength. In recognition of her outstanding contribution Eva has been appointed as a Patron of JewishCare, a position that was last held by Major General Paul Cullen until his passing in 2007.

Over the year each Board member has made a valuable contribution. I would particularly like to acknowledge the diligence of the Executive, Tony Breuer (Vice President), Lawrence Myers (Treasurer) and Allen Linz (the leader of our Building Committee)

I would also like to thank our State and Federal Governments, the Jewish Communal Appeal and the Conference on Jewish Material Claims Against Germany for the funding provided as noted in the Treasurer's Report, as well as all the individuals and organisations who so generously supported us over the year and most importantly, to thank our clients who have put their faith in us and who continue to inspire us every day.

The 2011 financial year was momentous for JewishCare on many levels. The organisation conducted a highly successful Capital Appeal which was strongly supported by the community and exceeded all expectations with commitments of approximately \$4.8M achieved.

These funds will predominantly be used for the construction of our new Saber Street property and creation of a strong base for cost effective future service delivery to the community. At the date of this report, around \$2.6M of Net Capital Appeal pledges have been received and around \$2M has been expended on the building works. Having recently settled the sale of our property at Leyland House in Bondi Junction, we are confident of our financial capacity to complete the project on time and on budget and ensure that the plans of recent years will be brought to fruition as envisaged.

The organisation reported a deficit of \$109,007 in 2011 before accounting for the Capital Appeal proceeds.

The deficit has been limited by careful cost control and ongoing cost save initiatives introduced by management in recent years. We are proud to report that this responsible fiscal outcome has been achieved in the context of an extension of JewishCare services with the appointment of 6 new Full time equivalent employees across our service lines, particularly in aged care and disability support services.

There has been neither any significant change in activities nor any material change in the revenue or expenditure structure.

SOURCES OF REVENUE

Government funding is the largest source of Jewishcare revenue, especially NSW Department of Ageing, Disability and Home Care, Commonwealth Department of Health and Ageing and Commonwealth Department of Families, Community Services and Indigenous Affairs. Collectively, government sources contributed around \$3.5M of revenue in 2011.

JewishCare received funding from the Jewish Communal Appeal (JCA) which is allocated annually following an application process. Being the recipient of the largest allocation of the community funds, JCA and JewishCare are working closely to ensure a transparent and satisfactory distribution of funds. The organisation received approximately \$2.2M from the JCA in 2011.

The third largest source of revenue is received from The Conference on Jewish Material Claims Against Germany

(Claims Conference) for programs helping Holocaust survivors. Claims conference contributions during the year were approximately \$1.63M. JewishCare continues to appreciate the financial support of these organisations. JewishCare earned income in the order of \$819,422 from its customers, contributing 8.76% of the total revenue. Donations and endowments amounted to \$0.8 million which represents 8.54% of JewishCare's income.

EXPENDITURE

Total expenditure for the year was \$9,467,310, an increase of \$871,755 on the previous year.

Around eighty percent of JewishCare's expenditure is comprised of staffing cost. Over the 2010-11 year JewishCare employed 240 staff members in addition to locums and consultants engaged in direct client support.

ASSETS

The Gross assets of JewishCare as at 30 June 2011 were \$13.31 million which was comprised predominantly of cash on hand to be expended on programs and Property, Plant and Equipment. The net assets of the organisation as at 30 June 2011 were \$10,945,632.

FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT

JewishCare's Finance and Administration staff continued to provide timely reporting to the Board and program managers. Budgeting processes are targeted and well controlled and program managers take fully responsibility for the performance of their areas.

BURGER CENTRE

In 2010-11 JewishCare continued its operation of The Burger Centre in partnership with Montefiore Home. The Burger Centre Pty Ltd is a registered company and the two shareholders have equal rights.

I extend my thanks to our auditors, Deloitte, the Senior Managers of the organisation and to the Finance and Administration team at JewishCare who have continued to steer the organisation admirably notwithstanding the extensive additional workload of our Capital Appeal and the Saber Street project.



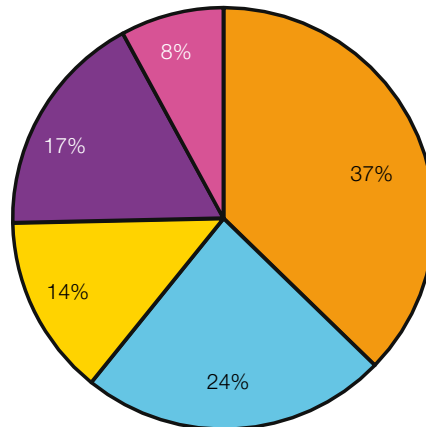

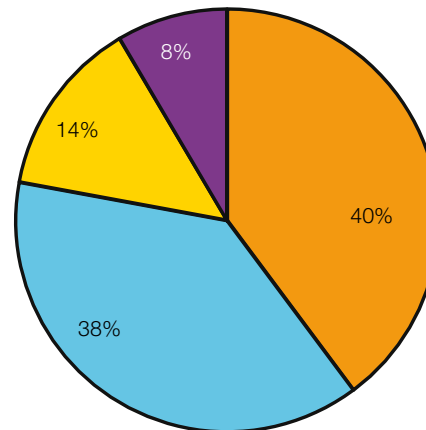

The Claims Conference was founded in 1951 to engage with the German and other Nazi compliant governments to negotiate material compensation for Jewish victims of Nazi persecution. Since that time tens of billions of dollars has been distributed throughout the world, especially to Israel.

JewishCare has been the major partner of the Claims Conference in NSW for over 15 years. Over that time JewishCare has acted as a conduit to help Survivors to navigate the process of accessing suitable funds as well as providing the required documentations. JewishCare has also worked closely with the Claims Conference to ensure their finite funding is allocated to the most needy people.

While JewishCare has assisted thousands of Survivors the organisation is mindful that available funds will almost certainly be exhausted before the needs of the last Survivors can be met. Judy McLallen who coordinates JewishCare's Restitution program summed up the latest initiative "The program operates on many levels not the least of which is providing Survivors with the opportunity to have their voices heard. We knew that many potentially eligible Survivors had not applied for the one-off BADV ghetto payment (2000 Euros) which expires on 31 December 2011 or the ZRBG ghetto pension, so we set about publicising these funds in the local Jewish press".

The response has been substantial and Judy has been approached by over 100 people and many have already received payments.

In July 1944 George Greenfeld was on the 3rd train out of Szeged in Hungary. The first two trains went to Auschwitz where most passengers perished. He was sent to Strausshoff for 10 days then spent the rest of the war working for a building firm in Czechoslovakia until he was liberated by the Russians in 1945.

George moved to Australia in 1955 where he married and had two children. In 2010 he was made aware of the BADV and ZEBG funds when he saw an ad in the Australian Jewish News and a friend told him how helpful JewishCare had been. George said "I don't know if I could have gone through this process on my own, Judy helped me so much. There are many forms to fill out and documents to produce but with Judy's guidance it was not all that difficult. I ended up submitting my application in March 2011 and by mid October I received the payment and will soon start receiving a monthly pension. On behalf of all the Survivors who have been helped by JewishCare I would like to thank them and the Claims Conference for their help".

Dr. Ilan Buchman the manager of the Child, Family and Community Services team

Ilan has extensive clinical and management experience gained in Australia and overseas. Prior to joining JewishCare in 1995, Ilan worked for 9 years as a senior child protection specialist and manager with Family and Children's Services in Perth. During this period he also taught at the School of Social Work at University of Western Australia and served as Vice President of The Australian Association of Social Workers. On arrival in Sydney he was appointed to the position of Official Visitor with Department of Corrective Services and a member of the Ethnic Affairs Task Force. In July 2003 in recognition of his involvement in social work education he was appointed Honorary Associate in the School of Social Work, University of NSW.

Ilan now manages the largest range of programs at JewishCare, eleven in all.

These include: The Big Brother Big Sister program and the newly established Mentoring program which improves the future capacities of young people who have faced challenges in their lives by linking them with volunteer role models, the Family Dispute Resolution program which provides services for divorcing couples and the Prison Outreach program supporting arguably the most marginalised group in our community, prisoners and their families.

Over the last 15 years Ilan has used his experience and qualifications to guide the growth and effectiveness of his team's programs. "We are constantly trying to ensure that our range of programs is responding to the current and future needs of our clients" said Ilan.

A good example of this has been the stall in Bondi Junction Mall each Friday which is staffed by the mental health team. This non-threatening community based initiative has helped JewishCare to engage with up to 40 individuals each week. Some of these are current clients while some may need our help in the future.

Another major initiative has been JewishCare's involvement in White Ribbon Day Mens Breakfast which over four years will have quadrupled in size and will have undoubtedly increased community awareness about the all too often overlooked issue of domestic violence.

"One of the changes I have noticed over recent times has been the increased requirement of evidence based reporting. My team has welcomed this as it ensures that the community knows we are spending their money appropriately and that we are really making a difference to vulnerable people in our community" said Ilan.

For over 20 years The Burger Centre has been synonymous with helping older members of the community to remain as active and independent as possible while remaining in their own homes.

When in 2006 the Centre moved to a purpose built facility in Randwick, as a joint venture between JewishCare and The Montefiore Home, an opportunity presented to substantially enhance the range of services that were able to be offered.

To fully realise its potential The Burger Centre needed a manager with vision and leadership. After an extensive and lengthy search the manager was found remarkably close to home, although in many respects she had travelled a very long way.

Suzi Parker was born in Glasgow and immigrated to Australia in 1986. She studied nursing in Glasgow became a Registered Nurse (RN) in 1984 a qualification she proudly maintains to this day. Other qualifications include a Graduate Diploma in Criminology, Graduate Diploma in Sexual Health Counselling and a Masters in Couple and Family Therapy.

For 6 years Suzi Parker had been working in a variety of roles at JewishCare. She set up the North Shore office, managed community development activities for JewishCare as a whole and at the time she was selected to take on the Burger Centre job she was JewishCare's volunteer coordinator.

Suzi said "I had seen first-hand the difference that The Burger Centre had made to the lives of many older people as well as their families and I was excited to take the Centre to the next level. The new facility offered a blank canvass with huge potential but I knew it was important to plan and grow within the capacities of all parties concerned"

Five years down the track and the results of all of the planning and vision are here for all to see. The Centre now operates both an Aged Day Care program as well as the Positive Ageing program. The former program still picks up frail aged clients and drops them home, provides nutritious kosher meals, organises entertainment and educational talks. But today the Centre is able to offer simultaneous dementia and non-dementia programs as well as a far greater range of facilities and accommodate more clients.

The Centre provides valuable respite to many families in the community who are caring for a loved one with dementia, and is able to offer carer support as well.

The Positive Ageing program follows the latest evidence based trends in healthy ageing in order to help attendees to acquire skills to keep fit, improve strength and balance and prevent falls. Activities include a modified form of Tai Chi, Hydro-cise held in the largest hydrotherapy pool in the Southern Hemisphere, Feldenkrais and Strength and Balance classes.

"Each week up to 150 people attend the Aged Day Care program and up to 140 attend Positive Ageing activities and I know that The Centre is playing an important and positive role in these people's lives. There is however considerable scope to provide an even wider range of activities especially as we plan to engage the Baby Boomers who will soon become an important part of the Centre's activities" Suzi concluded.

Over the last couple of years changes to the Award system and the general industrial relations landscape in our sector has made this a challenging time to manage any workforce let alone one as diverse as the 189 people who are employed by JewishCare.

Against an industry trend to casualise the workforce JewishCare is proud to maintain a high percentage of part time and full time employees to give people certainty of ongoing employment. Our staff consists of 47 full-time, 123 part-time and 19 casuals. Our employees range in age from 19 to 75 and is made up of 44 men and 143 women. Over 95% of our employees hold degrees or industry specific Cert III, IV or Diplomas.

Andy Kellahan has been JewishCare’s Human Resources manager since 2007. Since then he has been instrumental in upgrading JewishCare’s Human Resources (HR) policies, procedures and practices.

Andy has also been in charge of introducing staff surveys which are seen as important indicators of staff satisfactions as well as the efficiency and health of an organisation. JewishCare chose to work with the highly credentialed Voice Project from Macquarie University to carry out comprehensive surveys with over 110 questions in 2007 and 2011.

Andy said “Overall the JewishCare staff responses benchmark very favourably compared to similar organisations and there have been many areas of improvement in responses between the two surveys”.

Among the most significant were that an increased proportion of staff

- Agree with the values of JewishCare (97% up from 89%)
- Like the kind of work they do (96% up from 92%)
- Are willing to put in extra effort for JewishCare (95% up from 84%)
- Understand how that their job contributes to the overall success of JewishCare (94% up from 91%)
- Believe that there is good communication across all sections of JewishCare (52% up from 29%)
- Stated that Senior Management listen to other staff (64% up from 42%)
- Responded that policies and procedures are efficient and well designed (70% up from 47%)
- Believe that JewishCare is good at selecting the right people for the right jobs (62% up from 42%)

“While there is always room for improvement there is considerable evidence to suggest that from an HR point of view JewishCare is well placed to meet the future needs of the community we serve” said Andy.

For over 12 years Nikki Ryan has been a member of the disability services team.

For two years she worked in the Beit Chaim program, which provides two to three hours a week of drop in support for people with a disability who are living in the community. This program helps clients to achieve their goals as well as helping them to attend appointments and do the shopping. Nikki said “ Two to three hours a week may not sound like a lot of time but in fact it makes a big differences and ensures that the client’s daily life and activities remain on track. It also enables us to address any issues that may arise before they become a major problem”.

For the last five years Nikki has been predominately working at one of JewishCare’s four disability houses which provide 24 hour supported accommodation to three or four clients. Nikki’s overriding goal is ensure that the residents have the best lives possible. She is the key worker for one of the residents Karen who lives in a house in Mascot. They jointly develop an Individual Plan (IP) each year and one of Nikki’s jobs is to report on the progress of this IP and last year 80% of her IP was achieved. Other important tasks including helping with weekly shopping and helping Karen prepare for important outings including Shabbat dinners with her family.

Over the years JewishCare has encouraged Nikki to complete many courses and training sessions and she currently holds a Certificate IV in Disability Services.

“We all get great support from Amber, the Manager of the Disability Services Team, Fanny Vacher, the house co-ordinator and the rest of the staff at head office. From a personal point of view the job is very satisfying, it has taught me understanding and the value of persistence. I have seen firsthand how happy Karen is now as a result of providing such a stable and caring environment and I am proud of what we are able to achieve. ” said Nikki.

CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER'S REPORT

Our current Strategic Plan has as one of the objectives to examine unmet and changing needs and one of the strengths of small community based organisations like JewishCare is our capacity to identify new and emerging issues in the community. We do this by monitoring the type of calls to FirstCall and the requests for help from clients. This ensures that the services we offer match the needs in the community.

During 2010-11 JewishCare launched two new programs in response to community need and increased support in a number of existing programs. The Mentoring for Young Adults commenced to provide role models and support to young adults aged 18 to 25 years and the first training of mentors and links with young adults have been completed. The East Links program is an extension of the very successful North Links where elderly socially isolated people are linked for medium to long term support with a trained volunteer. The extension now means that this program is available in the Eastern Suburbs.

The Friendship Clubs were increased by one with the establishment of a Club at Cremorne. These Clubs, which now total 12 across Sydney, are run by the members and allow for a regular social connection by Jewish seniors. The support by JewishCare includes the publication of Keeping In Touch a magazine which includes news from all the Clubs.

Our second staff climate survey was held and the results presented to the Board in August. It showed considerable improvement in a number of areas and provided evidence that staff feel a strong connection to the organisation and its mission and objectives. We are taking the opportunity in this Annual Report to showcase some of our staff.

The Capital Appeal provided a wonderful opportunity to raise awareness in the community about the work we do and to fundraise to ensure our new home at Bondi Junction is constructed. 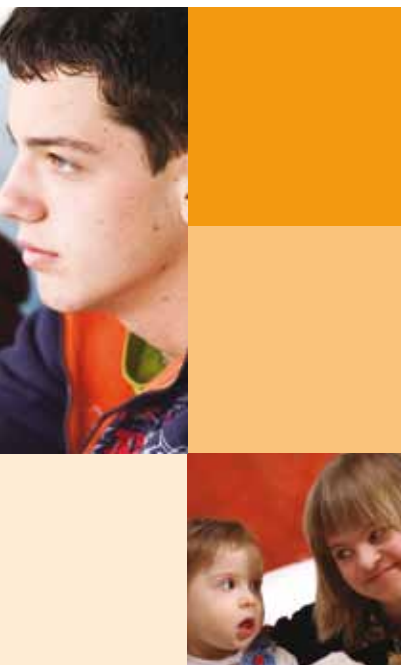
