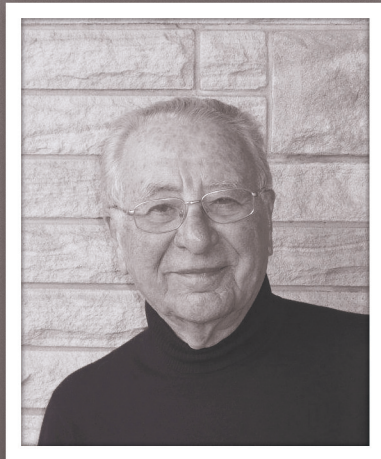


Steven Stux for JewishCare
