JCare

Jcare provides access to Care Workers who can be engaged by clients to assist with daily self-care and basic living tasks. This care can be provided in the person's own home or at another appropriate location eg school or residential care facility.

What the Care Worker can provide

Care Workers are responsive to the changing needs of clients and will offer a flexible range of services. The type of assistance offered may include:

- Accompanying clients to attend appointments, go on outings and help with shopping
- Providing personal care such as showering and dressing as well as basic home administration
- Assisting with domestic duties such as cooking, cleaning, ironing and laundry
- Companionship, which may include reading to clients or sharing various forms of entertainment
- Attendance times are flexible and Care Workers can sleepover/live-in or will attend at nominated times during the day

Who may benefit from JCare

- Any person who needs help to remain independent and active
- The frail aged who may be having difficulties with daily living and particularly in maintaining a clean and safe domestic environment
- JCare may be particularly valuable to assist an older person to remain in their own home, instead of having to move into residential care
- Any person with dementia or challenging behaviours who requires extra support
- Any person who is feeling isolated as a result of their stage of life or disability or mental state
- Families who have members with a severe illness and require extra support
- Priority will be given to people being discharged from hospital and where an existing family member who has previously acted as a carer is either temporarily absent or is now unable to continue to provide the appropriate level of care
- JCare may be suitable for a person who is waiting for a government or community care package to become available

Who are the Care Workers

- Care Workers come from a variety of backgrounds, have a wide range of interests and skills and may be fluent in a number of languages
- The program co-ordinator will ensure that the worker is appropriate for the cultural sensitivities and physical needs of the client
- All Care Workers are interviewed by JCare's experienced professional staff and are carefully screened prior to any personal information being divulged about a potential client.
